Environmental Information Regulations 2004 Request Planning 106 Obligations Redrow Homes

I refer to your FOI request above.

I can advise you that there are no Section 106 Agreements in Northern Ireland Legislation. The mechanism by which Planning Obligations are dealt with is through a Section 76 Planning Agreement (previously known as an Article 40 Planning Agreement).


Derry City and Strabane Council was formed under the Local Government Act (Northern Ireland) 2014 and has been effective since 1st April 2015. Under the Planning Northern Ireland Order 1991, Article 40 Planning Agreements existed, however since the transfer of local government in April 2015 these powers transferred to Council; and the Article 40 Agreements are now known as Section 76 Planning Agreements, under the Planning Act Northern Ireland 2011.

I note you have requested 15 years of data, and as explained above, the data held therefore relates to both DOE Article 40 Planning Agreements and Council Section 76 Planning Agreements. The returns for both Council and DOE for the last 5 years are as follows.

2015-2016 – One signed S76 by Council for housing development of approx. 1500 dwellings on Zoned H1B lands. The main signatory was Moore Construction, with no involvement of Redrow Homes or their subsidiaries, Harrow Estates or Bridgemere Land.

I note you have requested the total monetary value of the Agreement. At this time, we do not have the resources available to provide you with a calculation. You can however request to view the signed Planning Agreement under FOI; or request a copy of same for your convenience, to which there may be a charge.

I trust this provides you with some clarification on your request.
