Environmental Information Regulations Request Penalty Charge Notices

Thank you for your request. Following a Review of Public Administration in Northern Ireland in 2015 off road car parks came under the control of Councils from the Department of Regional Development, now called Department for Infrastructure. However, Council has entered into a Service Level Agreement with DfI (referred to as Transport NI, Parking Enforcement Unit) who are responsible for the delivery of the civil enforcement, Penalty Charge Notice (PCN) processing and management of offstreet car parks.

Council will receive the requested information from the Department however this will not be received within the 20-day EIR response time-frame. I therefore suggest you refer your queries to:
